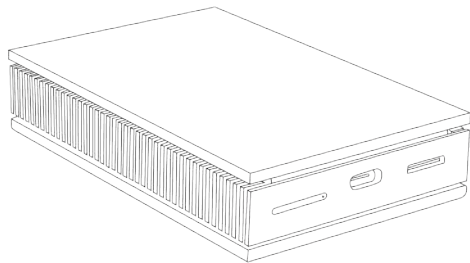


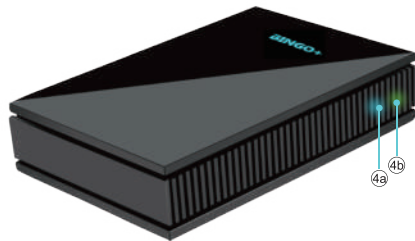
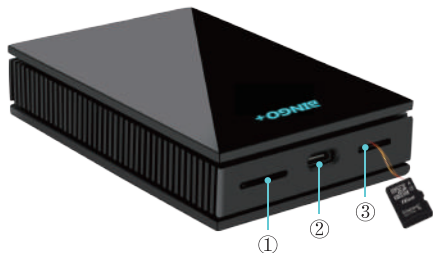

Introduction



- ① Sim Card Tray
- ② USB-C Port
- ③ TF Card Slot (Insert Red TF Card as shown above)
- ④ LED
 - ④a Blue LED: Indicates Bingo is Working
 - ④b Red LED: Indicates Power Supply

Note: When plugging Bingo into the vehicle's USB port, the red LED (4b) will light and the blue LED (4a) on the side of the device will flash quickly to show that it is loading into the OEM system. Once loaded, the blue LED will flash slowly.

When updating the software or resetting your device, the red LED will flash and the blue LED always on.

Installation

Connect the device to the original car carplay by the USB cable provided, then choose "Apple Carplay" in the car screen to enter the Android system (some cars can directly enter the Android system without clicking on the screen).



Connect Remote (Non-Touchscreen)

If your vehicle is non-touchscreen, you will need to connect the Bluetooth remote that came with your Bingo.

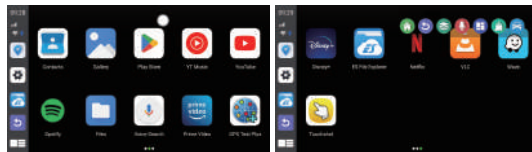
Using your factory controls please go to Settings>Connected Devices>Pair New Device. Once there please hold the Home and Select button (The circle button in between the arrows) on your remote together for a few seconds until the red light starts flashing more slowly. Your remote should then show up on the list of available devices on your Bingo with the name G10s Pro, please then select the remote and it will automatically pair with your device.









Once your remote has been connected it may turn off the virtual keyboard on your Bingo, if this happens, please go to Settings>Languages & Input>Physical Keyboard>Click show Virtual Keyboard.

Main Features

1) Home Page and Menu

See below our home page, you can press and hold the icons to move and customise your layout.



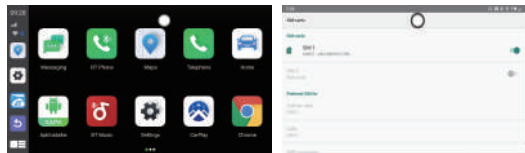
-  Click on the screen and our control centre button appears, click on this button to open the control centre.

2) Connect and Disconnect to the Internet

Wi-Fi: Go to the settings Application and click "Network and internet". Switch Wi-Fi on, find the network you want to connect to and enter the password.

If you are using your personal hotspot to connect to the internet, please ensure this is turned on in your phone's settings.

4G: Ensure your Sim Card is inserted into the tray correctly. If connected, there will be a 4G icon on the main menu above the Wi-Fi icon. You can check to see if your 4G connection is working in "Network & Internet" in the Settings application.



Disconnect to the Internet:

Method 1: Click the WiFi icon shown in the picture - 2. A prompt window will pop up - 3. Click disconnect (this method only disconnects the carplay, and does not turn off the mobile phone WiFi)

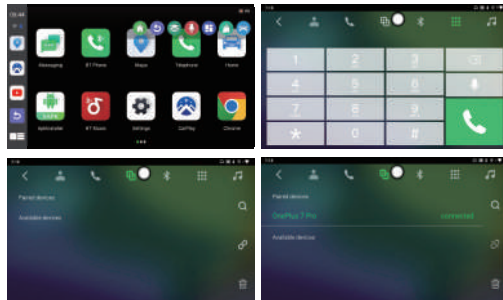
Method 2:

Directly turn off the mobile phone WiFi:
Settings---->Wireless LAN--->Close



3) Bluetooth

To use the Bluetooth feature first make sure your device is not connected to the vehicle's Bluetooth. Go to the BT Phone application shown below, search for the device you want to connect to and click pair. Alternatively, you can connect via your device by searching for Bingo in Bluetooth.



4) Wireless Carplay and Android Auto

Wireless Carplay : Connect your iPhone via Bluetooth to Bingo and click on the CarPlay App

Image 1 below shows the wireless CarPlay system activating, you will then receive a pop up on iPhone, click use CarPlay on the pop up (Image 2) The CarPlay interface will then load on your screen (Image 3).

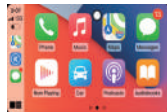

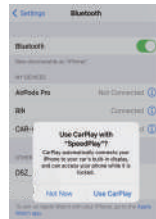
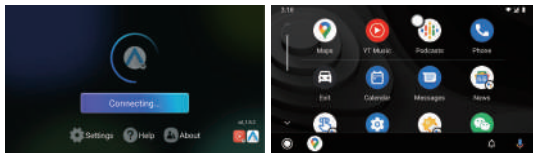

Android Auto : Connect your Android phone to Bingo via Bluetooth and select the CarPlay application 📶. Android Auto will automatically load onto your screen.

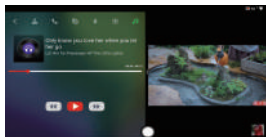


5) Video and Audio

With Bingo you can play your own music and movies from a TF Card (not included) or you can stream from the internet using applications such as Netflix&YouTube.You can use the Split Screen function in the Control Centre to use other applications whilst watching video.

6) Split screen function

Click 📺 icon from the floating icon to perform split screen operation, can show 2 Apps at the sam time, such as BT music and Youtube;



7) Settings

Settings - "Navigation Application Settings" of BINGO+ Settings, select the desired map, and return to the main interface to display the map. As shown below



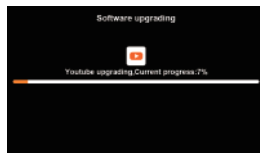
In Settings menu , can set WiFi,Language,Bluetooth,Date and Time, Factory setting,etc.

Software Update

- 1)Copy the latest Bingo software onto a blank TF Card and insert into the TF Card slot ③.
- 2)Click yes on the pop up to start the update.
- 3)Please be patient. The car screen will return to the factory system.
- 4)The Bingo interface will automatically load back onto your carsscreen.
- 5)Please let the device update itself and do not unplug or remove the TF Card till the interface is useable again.

Please Note

- Do not turn off or unplug Bingo whilst it is updating, until the updated software has reloaded onto your car screen.
- Both the red and blue LED on Bingo will start flashing quickly.
- Do not take the TF card out till the process is done.



Troubleshooting

| Problem | Solution |
|--|---|
| Bingo is not loading onto your car screen. | 1) Ensure your vehicle has wired Apple CarPlay/Android Auto. 2) Check to see if the LED is flashing correctly. 3) Ensure the cable is plugged in properly and in the correct USB port |
| No GPS Signal | 1) Make sure Bingo is facing upwards with the logo pointing towards the roof of the car. 2) There may be something in the vehicle blocking GPS signal e.g heated or metallic windscreen. |
| No Signal from Sim Card | 1) Make sure the Sim Card is inserted correctly. 2) Check if SIM card is working in another compatible device e.g mobile phone. |
| Lag or Device Freezing | 1) Restore factory settings in settings application. |

Most issues can be resolved by factory resetting your device by going to "Settings>More>System>Advance>Reset Options>Eras All Data(Factory Reset)."
